Sheriff DuBois and District Attorney Hoovler Announce the Arrest of Five Subjects for Prostitution, Patronizing Prostitution and Drug Possession In the Town of Wallkill, N.Y.

*The Orange County Drug Task Force And Town of Wallkill Police Department
Charge Two Defendants With Prostitution,
and Three Defendants with Patronizing a Prostitute*

Town of Wallkill, NY - On January 19, 2017, the Orange County Drug Task Force and the Town of Wallkill Police Department conducted a joint prostitution investigation in the Town of Wallkill, N.Y. Two women were arrested and charged with Prostitution, a Class "B" Misdemeanor. Three men were arrested and charged with Patronizing a Prostitute in the Third Degree, a Class "A" Misdemeanor. One man was also charged with Unlawful Possession of Marijuana, a Violation.

Arrested in the joint prostitution investigation were:

John Liporace, 56, of Middletown. Liporace was charged with Patronizing a Prostitute. Liporace was released with an appearance ticket and is scheduled to appear in the Town of Wallkill Court.

Gene Vivaldo, 23, of Middletown was charged with Patronizing a Prostitute and Unlawful Possession of Marijuana. Vivaldo was released with an appearance ticket and is scheduled to appear in the Town of Wallkill Court.

Yondo Nyadjroh, 26, of New Rochelle, was charged with Prostitution. Nyadjroh was released with an appearance ticket and is scheduled to appear in the Town of Wallkill Court.

Benja Rosario, 22 of New York City, was charged with Prostitution. Rosario was released with an appearance ticket and is scheduled to appear in the Town of Wallkill Court.

Michael Rosenberger, 49, of Maybrook, was charged with Patronizing a Prostitute. Rosenberger was released with an appearance ticket and is scheduled to appear in the Town of Wallkill Court.

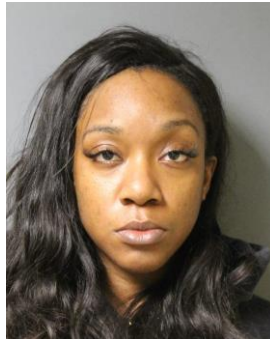
All Defendants were issued an Appearance Tickets returnable to Wallkill Town Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
