Diana Names New IT Commissioner
Broome County's McKinney Makes Move to Orange

Goshen – Orange County Executive Edward A. Diana is pleased to announce the appointment of Kim S. McKinney as Commissioner of the Orange County Department of Information Technology (IT).

“We’re happy to welcome Ms. McKinney to Orange County,” said County Executive Diana. “She comes to us with more than 30 years experience in information technology management in the public, private, and academic sectors. “For the past 18 years, she served as Chief Information Officer and Director of Information Technology for Broome County Government where she played a key role on the county’s leadership team and lead the modernization of the county’s information technology infrastructure,” continued Diana.

As Commissioner, Ms. McKinney will oversee the County’s Wide Area Network and an IT team that provides service and support to all County agencies and locations, as well as 23 municipal assessors, and more than 2,000 technology users at locations throughout Orange County. In addition to managing the County’s extensive data and communication services, Ms. McKinney will also oversee Orange County’s Records Management Center and Geographical Information Services (GIS).

Ms. McKinney earned her Master of Business Administration in Management Information Systems from SUNY Binghamton and a Bachelor of Science in Operations Management from Pennsylvania State University. She was honored with the first-ever New York State Public Sector CIO of the Year award and was elected to the NYS CIO Leadership Committee and appointed co-chair of the NYS CIO Council Open Government, Collaboration, and Communication Committee. Her appointment is subject to confirmation by the Orange County Legislature.
